Psalm 32:5 “Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, ‘I will confess my transgressions to the Lord’ -and you forgave the guilt of my sin.”

B. It's _____ Vs. 5

“Not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy.”

Romans 4:7 “Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.”

D. I'm Vs. 5

"He saved us through the washing of rebirth..."

"And He said, 'These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.'" Rev. 7:14

"Have mercy on me, O God... 2 Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin... 7 Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow... 9 Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. 10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." Psalm 51:1-12

Why? The blood of Christ..... the stain of sin.

E. I'm Vs. 5-6a

"...and renewal by the Holy Spirit, 6 whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior."

Additional Passages: 2 Cor. 3:18, Rom. 8:29-30
